The 2008 Pinot Noir Yamhill Cuvee is medium ruby in color with an expressive nose of spicy red fruits and considerable terroir character. On the palate the fruit leans to the dark side of the spectrum with intense black cherry and black raspberry flavors as well as excellent grip, balance, and length. This tasty effort can be enjoyed now but has the stuffing to evolve for 2-3 years.

Domaine Serene's 2008 Pinot Noirs are outstanding across the portfolio.

Give it 2-3 years of cellaring and drink it over the following 15+ years.
